STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

MR MOHAMMED MOGHUL

A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Mr Mohammed Moghul, a magistrate appointed to the Bradford Bench, failed to complete the minimum number of sittings required of a magistrate or the necessary training. He also failed to keep in contact with the court. As a result, the Lord Chief Justice and the Lord Chancellor have agreed that he should be removed from the magistracy.”
