STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

MRS BEVERLEY SQUIRE-WIGGINS

A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“After requesting a twelve month break from sitting, Mrs Beverley Squire-Wiggins has failed to keep in contact with her bench or informed them of her intention not to return to sitting. Given these circumstances the Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have agreed that she should be formally removed from the magistracy.”
