## **STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS**

### **RECORDER LINCOLN CRAWFORD**

#### **A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:**

“Lincoln Crawford, a Recorder on the South Eastern Circuit and a fee paid Chairman in the Employment Tribunal has stood down from both of his judicial offices. Mr Crawford was the subject of ongoing disciplinary proceedings at the time but in accepting his resignation, the Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice have indicated that they will take no further action. They have acknowledged Mr Crawford’s past judicial performance and his outstanding contribution to diversity issues in the legal world and beyond.”
